# Bazaar Guidelines for Vendors

**We are accepting reservations and collecting fees to fill 250 spaces for the 2021 Holiday Bazaar. Returning Vendors can register beginning June 1st and are asked to mail registration and check before Sept. 1st to guarantee a space. New vendor registrations and checks will be taken after Sept. 1st and will fill according to availability.**

- We ask that you only sell HANDCRAFTED items. Anything you sell must be appropriate to be displayed in a public school.
- **Food Sales:** The Boosters sell food concessions, so we request vendors do not sell food items for on-premises consumption. Clark County Health Regulators have restricted open samples in the past due to lack of availability of running water. Please check with them for your individual situation. The Health Department will inspect on the day of the Bazaar.
- **Tables:** There are only 90 rectangular tables available. Rectangle tables will be awarded by the postmark on the registration without exception. All other table requests will be round tables. Only 1 table per space rented will be provided. **If you bring your own table, we will give you 1 ticket per space to our prize table as a way of saying, "Thank you".**
- **Email:** A current email is required for all verification and correspondence. Confirmation emails will be sent in September; mail will only be checked a few times over the summer. If you do not provide a valid email address, we will have to return your registration.
- Set up time begins at 7:00am on Saturday November 13th. No early birds - the building will not be accessible and students and volunteers won't be able to help you earlier than 7am.
- Please clean up promptly after the bazaar ends at 4:00pm
- Students are available to help you bring in your items and return them to your vehicle. Students cannot help you set up your booth nor can MVIM boosters be responsible for broken items.
- **NEW: Electrical Power** accessibility has changed due to school modifications with **limited locations**. Returning vendors with previous power needs will be accommodated to our best ability. New requests for power, even as a returning vendor may not be accommodated; if we can give you access to power, your location may change.
- If requested, we will do our best to place you in the same location as last year **if registration is received in between June 1st - September 1, 2020. WE CANNOT GUARANTEE THE SAME LOCATION.** If you request more spaces than the previous year, we cannot guarantee your space will be the same.
- **SPACE SIZE:** 8ft. wide x 6 ft deep. Vendors must stay within marked boundaries. Aisles cannot be blocked due to fire code. The Fire Marshall will perform an inspection the day of the bazaar.
- You are responsible for any sales or use taxes that may be levied against you by the State. We do not forward vendor information at any time unless required by law. 100% of your earnings remain with you.
